Recommended Local Nurseries per HOA Visits (note: this is in relation to and RBV homeowner needed to replace a tree in their front yard)

Nurseries

Moon Valley 36705 Briggs Rd 92563 – Moon Valley (corporate nursery) is very different compared to the others we visited, their pricing is high, but it includes delivery and professional planting (they can remove at a price). They have the trees from 15 gallon, 24" and 36" box planters as well as fully grown. Moon Valley has all the trees on our list, but staff recommended their favorite tree, Western Redbud. Pricing: Moon Valley bases their price on the size of the tree so there is not a standard list of prices like the others.

For the nurseries below their pricing well seem a lot lower than Moon River but we have no clue how much a landscaper would charge if a homeowner contracted to have a tree in a 36-inch box planted?

French Valley Nusery 34155 Winchester Rd 92596 – local nursery, they have all of the trees and ground cover that Nathan recommended except the Chinese Flame. They do deliver (think \$65). The container/box sizes they currently have are from 15 gal, 24" and some 36". The prices are \$89.99 for 15 gal, \$249.99 for 24" and \$599.99 for 36". They mentioned that there is potential for discounts but again based on volume.

Curbys Nursery 31900 Calle Chapos (across from Summers Bend) local nursery, they have all of the trees and ground cover that Nathan recommended and recommended their favorite ground cover, dwarf carpet of stars. They do deliver (\$65). The container/box sizes they have are from 15 gal, 24" and some 36" boxes but very by the tree type. They start at \$55 for 15-gal, 24 inches very by tree but they are between \$160 to \$199. If they have the tree in 36 inches, it is \$550. For ground cover, Acacia runs between \$5.50 to \$14.50 based on the container size. The Dwarf Carpet of Stars is \$23 for a standard flat.

DLM Nursery 34235 Leon Rd 92596 This nursery was recommended by our Landscape Contractor Nathan Adams as having good product and prices.

Discounts: all the nurseries will offer discounts on volume purchases it appears. Curbys though appeared to be willing to entertain the idea of having a day for an HOA that was organized for several homeowners came to purchase plants – would need to check.
